SANCTUARY ROOF AND TOWER

By the time you receive this happy newsletter, the work will be finished. On the Sanctuary Roof, some 85 broken slate have been replaced. All gutters have been cleaned and brought up to shape. The Tower has a new roof on top of the old that is covered with a heavy rubber membrane that will tolerate both heat and cold for years to come.

The roof hatch which had been open for some 15 years, has been rebuilt and secured. Alas, this has left many pigeons quite sad since the Tower is now off-limits to them. But be assured, they did leave their enduring mark. For example, our bell is no doubt more muted in its peal. More ringing might save us from some pigeons.
